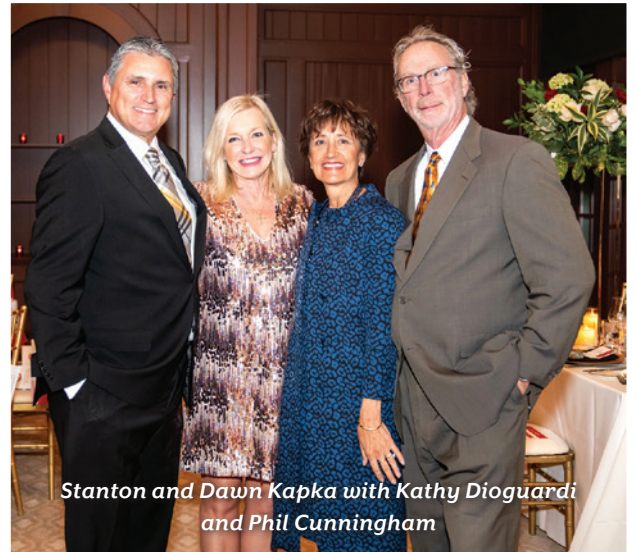
A PROMISE TO THE NEXT GENERATION
