Barrington Youth & Family Services saw a significant increase in clients due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As is no surprise, the pandemic worsened existing mental health problems and led to more cases of anxiety and depression among children and adolescents because of the unique combination of the public health crisis, lack of school, missed milestones, social isolation and loneliness, and economic recession. Parents, too, are struggling with issues exacerbated by the pandemic.

This, all ongoing at a time when BYFS is seeing more patients and increasing its scholarships to families that were affected financially by the pandemic. We do not expect this to subside in 2021.

At BYFS, we are committed to serving the Barrington community for people ages 5 and up during these trying times. It is our goal to never have to turn people away due to their ability to pay. More than 75% of the clients we see receive some form of financial subsidy from us. For example, we provided \$28,000 in financial aid in 2020 to families needing mental health services that we provide.
