CFC's Native Plant Sale Opens March 1 Online





ONLINE ORDERING for Citizens for Conservation's 28th annual Spring Native Plant, Shrub and Tree Sale is available from March 1 through April 15 at citizensforconservation.org. Orders are filled on a first-come-first-filled basis, so order early, and pre-orders are encouraged if you have a specific plant in mind. The in-person sale will be held May 4–5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at CFC's Hill 'N Dale Preserve in Barrington Hills. Online order pickup will be Friday, May 3, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday, May 4 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., at the sale site. CFC members can shop the sale on May 3, and members get a 10 percent discount on all days. Volunteer opportunities will be posted at the Barrington Area Volunteer Connection in March, or email cfc@citizensforconservation.org. Contact CFC at 847-382-7283.

The sale features many species of plants that support local pollinators, including two expertly designed garden kits:

Pollinator Garden for a Compact Space Species selected for a small space (28 sq. ft.) and to attract hummingbirds, bumblebees, beetles, and butterflies.

The Danaus Dozen Maybe everyone's favorite, the monarch (Danaus Plexippus) butterfly undergoes a fascinating life cycle consisting of four distinct stages. While milkweed is important for the first stage, when the female butterfly lays her eggs on the plant, this garden kit will support two later stages of the life cycle during the time that monarchs are still in our area, May through September.
