

"Penwern/A Visual Study" Is Published by Peter Yankala

PETER YANKALA, owner of Phillips Men's Wear Studio in Barrington, has long put his keen camera skills to work, sharing his gorgeous images ranging from the countryside of Barrington to breathtaking views from the tops of the tallest buildings in Chicago. As a tour guide and docent for the Frank Lloyd Wright Trust and Chicago Architecture Foundation, Yankala's skill for architectural photography has been perfected over the years.

His recently published book, "Penwern/A Visual Study," showcases Yankala's exceptional photography on behalf of the Penwern property, a summer estate designed and built by Frank Lloyd Wright (1900-1902). Over several years, Yankala gathered images across the seasons at the location in Southern Wisconsin and conducted endless interviews about the estate's history. Originally known as the Fred B. Jones House, its current owners are former Barrington Hills residents—and customers at Phillips Men's Wear. The two parties reconnected, and the result is Yankala's excellent study, now secured for the ages. Yankala grew up learning about Frank Lloyd Wright from his father.
