## Congratulations to the State Champion BHS Girls Varsity Golf Team!

**ON OCTOBER 9, 2021**, the Barrington High School Varsity Girls Golf Team won the Class 2A IHSA State Championship, taking the top spot over Stevenson High School, followed by Loyola Academy. In addition, BHS senior Mara Janess took the individual state title for the second time and BHS senior Sophia Sulkar tied for 2nd place in the individual tournament.

Janess became the first state champion in history for the BHS Girls Golf Team in 2019 when she was a sophomore at BHS. The win marks the first time in BHS history that the Varsity Girls Golf Team has won the state championship. The team had three straight 2nd place finishes in 2016-2018.





## Peter Yankala's Frank Lloyd Wright Photos Featured in Japanese Magazine "CAL"

**WHEN WE HEARD ABOUT** Peter Yankala's coverage in Japan, we asked him to share the news.

"CAL Magazine is a Japanese special interest print magazine. CAL Cars and Lifestyle is pointed at exposing American lifestyle to Japan's culture. Frank Lloyd Wright has been a fan favorite in Japan since his Imperial Hotel project 1909 in Tokyo.

The publisher of CAL, Hommo Osamu who resides in Tokyo, contacted The Frank Lloyd Wright Foundation looking for photographers for 12 of Wrights USA masterpieces. Along with the Guggenheim, New York, Hollyhock House in Los Angeles, and Robie House, Chicago, they chose Penwern as the only privately owned feature.

I was thrilled to be asked. When I started my personal study on the Fred B Jones House (Penwern Estate) my intent was to catalogue the near-perfect and 20-year restoration of the rare and under documented summer estate by America's architect, Frank Lloyd Wright. My research of the 8-acre estate revealed that the owners/stewards were former Barrington Hills residents, and customers of mine at Phillips. The unrestricted access for months allowed me to submit hundreds of shots featuring the architecture and setting of this rare summer estate on the shore of Lake Delavan, Wisconsin. To see my work surrounded by Japanese language and characters is one of those events in life that qualifies as "Who'd of thunk it?" – Peter Yankala


